5. *I understand that if the level of difficulty proves to be too demanding, my child may not be able to change his/her schedule based on the constraints of the master schedule.*
6. *I further understand that a course change requested after the master schedule is built may be disruptive to other aspects of the student's schedule. Thus, students should make sure that the courses selected, or waived into, are the courses and levels they intend to keep for the duration of the 2023-2024 school year.*
7. *Finally, I understand that **April 28, 2023** is the deadline for obtaining and submitting waiver signatures to the Counseling Office. No waivers will be accepted beyond this date.*
